**Camacho Campaign Reports Continued Community Support for County Schools**

[SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO, CA] – The campaign of Héctor Camacho for San Mateo County Superintendent of Schools today released an updated fundraising report reflecting ongoing support for public education and for a shared vision for the future of local schools. This milestone was made possible by the generosity of community members across the county.

As of December 31, 2025, the campaign has received more than \$100,000 in total contributions, according to its latest filing covering the period from July 1 through December 31, 2025. The election for San Mateo County Superintendent of Schools is scheduled for June 2, 2026.

Contributors to the campaign now represent every city and every school district in San Mateo County, with many gifts ranging from \$5 to \$100, reflecting a campaign powered by families, teachers, classified staff, and neighbors across the county.

“This campaign has always been about community,” said Camacho. “These contributions represent people who believe in our schools and want to be part of sustaining and strengthening them for the next generation.”

Camacho has spent more than two decades in public education, serving as a paraprofessional, classroom teacher, school leader, and university administrator. He also served 11 years on the San Mateo County Board of Education before being named Executive Director at the San Mateo County Office of Education. His campaign focuses on literacy, workforce development, and partnerships that support student learning and well-being.

“As we reflect on the leadership and progress that have shaped our county’s schools, this is a moment to recognize the community that continues to show up for our children,” Camacho said. “Every contribution is a vote of confidence in our kids and in what public education can become when we build it with care. I am grateful for that trust, and I carry it with humility.”

With this momentum, the campaign will expand community listening sessions, volunteer organizing, and voter outreach in the months ahead. The work continues, powered by neighbors who believe every child in San Mateo County deserves the opportunity to thrive.
