Camacho Releases Strong First Fundraising Report, Powered by Countywide Support

[SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO, CA] – Héctor Camacho’s campaign for San Mateo County Superintendent of Schools has released its first major fundraising report, showing early momentum and deep support from across the county. The campaign has raised \$54,269 from supporters in nearly every corner of San Mateo County, reflecting a broad and growing coalition behind Camacho’s vision for strong, inclusive public schools.

Campaign contributors represent communities from Daly City to Menlo Park, Half Moon Bay to Redwood City, with people from all walks of life, including educators, parents, community leaders, and lifelong advocates for children. The campaign’s first financial filing covers all fundraising through June 30, 2025.

“This campaign has never been about one person,” said Camacho. “It’s about every child in San Mateo County, and the families and educators who are working every day to help them thrive.”

Camacho noted that while the campaign is proud of its early support, its focus remains on serving students, not politics. “Our schools need leadership that brings people together to solve problems. That’s the kind of campaign we’re building, and that’s the kind of County Superintendent I intend to be.”

In addition to the widespread community support, Camacho has earned broad backing from local leaders, including State Senator Josh Becker, Assemblymember Diane Papan, County Supervisors Noelia Corzo and Lisa Gauthier, and a majority of the members of the San Mateo County Board of Education, among dozens of early endorsements.

Camacho is a lifelong educator who currently serves as Executive Director at the San Mateo County Office of Education. He previously served for 11 years as a trustee on the San Mateo County Board of Education.

Before joining the County Office of Education, Camacho spent 25 years working across the education system — as a teacher, counselor, school administrator, advocate, and higher education leader — always grounded in a commitment to ensuring that every child has the opportunity to learn, grow, and thrive in a safe and inclusive school environment.
