**Camacho Campaign Shows Strong Grassroots Momentum in Latest Filing**

**[SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO, CA]** – The campaign of Héctor Camacho for San Mateo County Superintendent of Schools today released its latest fundraising report, highlighting strong grassroots support and continued momentum across the county.

According to the campaign’s filing covering the period ending April 18, 2026, the campaign raised over \$23,000 this reporting period, bringing total contributions to more than \$125,000 to date.

The campaign has now received more than 400 individual contributions, including 258 donations of \$100 or less, reflecting broad community support from educators, families, and local residents across San Mateo County.

“This campaign is powered by people who believe every child matters. Whether it’s \$5 or \$500, it all adds up to one thing: a community that’s all in for every child and every voice,” said Camacho.

The report also reflects the costs of running a transparent, countywide campaign, including a \$2,531.36 candidate filing fee and an \$8,200 candidate statement fee, required to reach more than 420,000 registered voters across San Mateo County.

With ballots arriving in less than two weeks, the campaign is expanding its outreach across the county. Volunteers have already knocked on hundreds of doors, made thousands of phone calls, and connected with voters in nearly every community.

Camacho is a proud product of San Mateo County public schools and, with his wife, is now raising their children in those same schools. Over nearly three decades, he has served students and families across the education system as a classroom aide, teacher, counselor, and school leader, and currently serves as Executive Director at the San Mateo County Office of Education.
